## **Summer Arts Camp Information**

This camp is organized and led by the Genesee Valley Council on the Arts. Because of the intent to provide a unique art experience, space is limited and available on a first come/first served basis.

The camp runs Monday through Thursday, July 26-29, 9:30am to 4pm. Unless other arrangements are made in advance, campers should be dropped off at the start time and picked up at the end time. The first day drop off point is Livingston Arts Center, 4 Murray Hill Drive, Mount Morris (rear parking lot). Parents/guardians will be advised about pick up and drop off points for the remainder of the week at that time.

Campers should bring a bag lunch. A refrigerator and coolers are available to keep cold items. Snacks will be provided and are included in the camp fee.

Most of the time is spent outdoors. Campers should dress appropriately, from head to toe, including good footwear. Extra clothing may be sent with campers.

In order for a camper to be fully registered, payment and release forms must be received in advance of the event by the Genesee Valley Council on the Arts.
